Philosophy:

Include some of their main theories e.g. for Plato, research the cave, and for Aristotle, look at what he said about virtue.

Include pictures, information, and make a note of two questions you have about either philosopher.

Include information on his life, and find out about what he meant when he referred to cheap and costly grace. Include pictures, information, and make a note of two questions you have about Bonhoeffer.
