**Raffle tickets are still available to purchase on Arbor** to support this project for one more week. There is also a **QR code** if you would like to make a donation to the appeal.



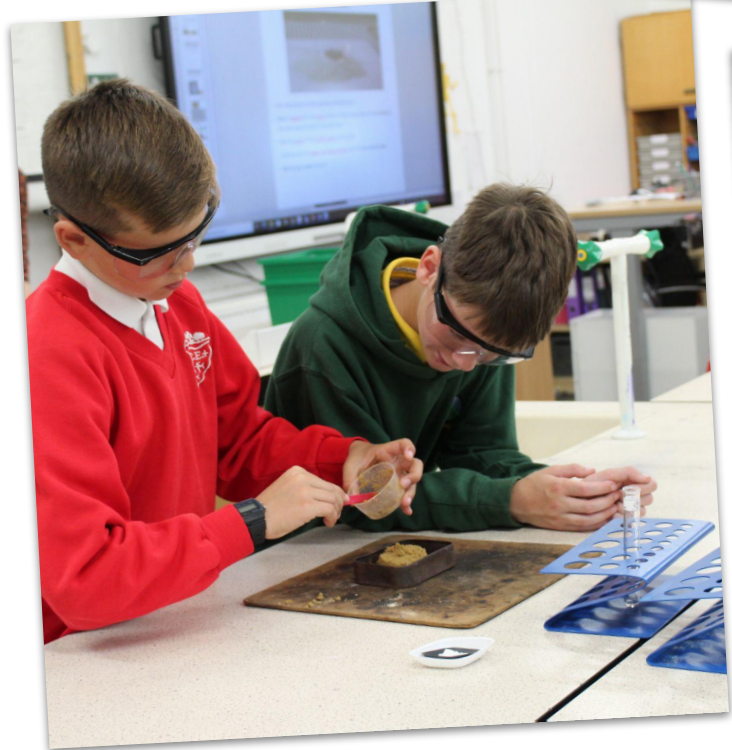

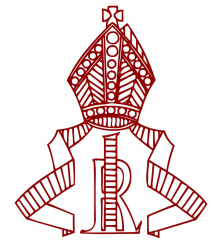






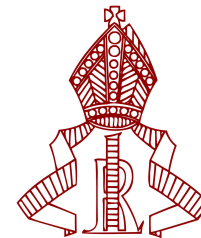


# What will change in Year 8?

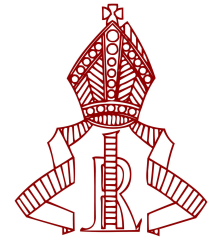

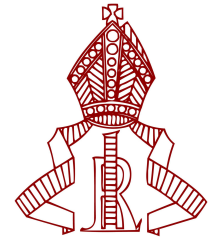

- Talk to them about online safety

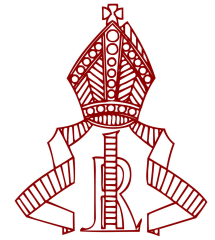
