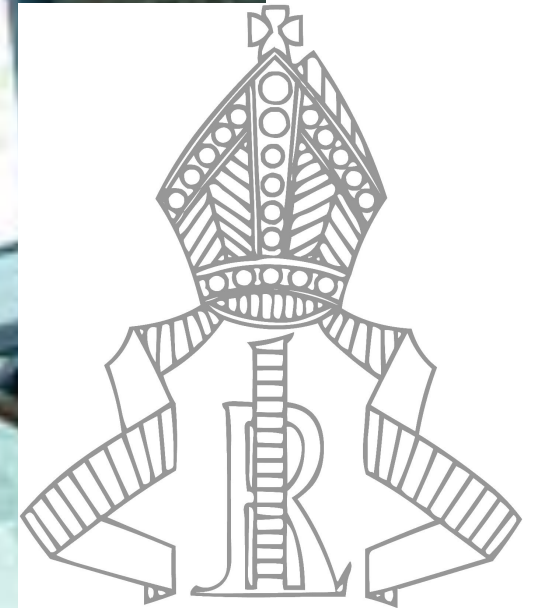

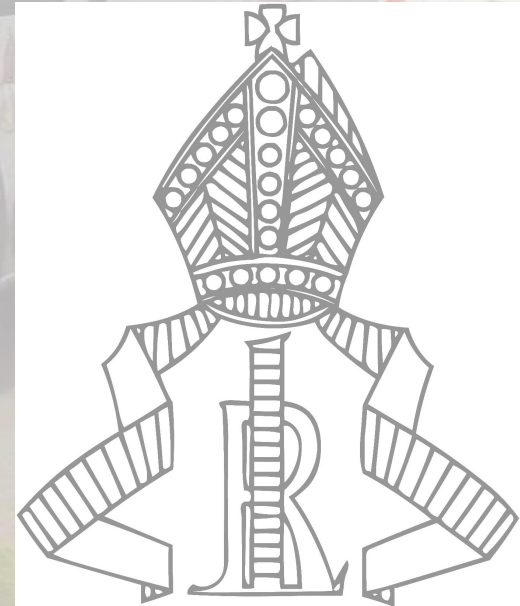

Diamond Legacy project

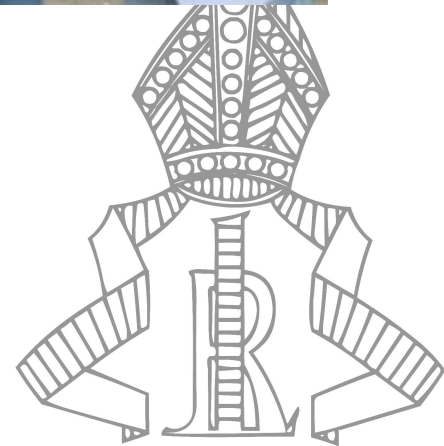

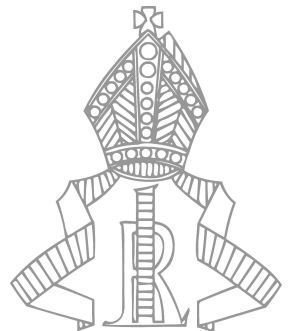

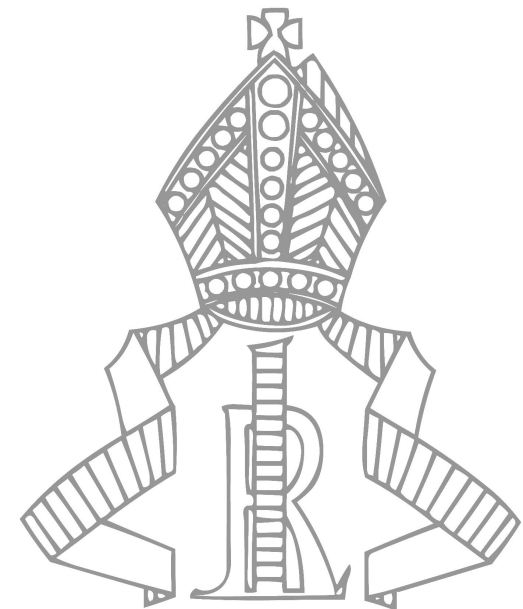
The Arbor App allows you to:

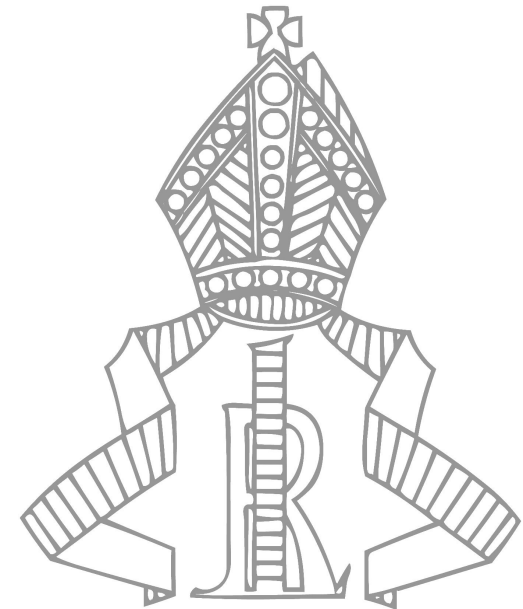
What you could do to help your children learn

- Talk to them!
- Talk to us!
- Be aware of the key dates.
- Make attendance a priority.
- Encourage attendance to revision sessions.
- Preparation for post-16 - Sixth Form, College etc.
- Check Arbor
- Encourage routine - sleep!
- Create a space to work
- **You can make the difference!!**



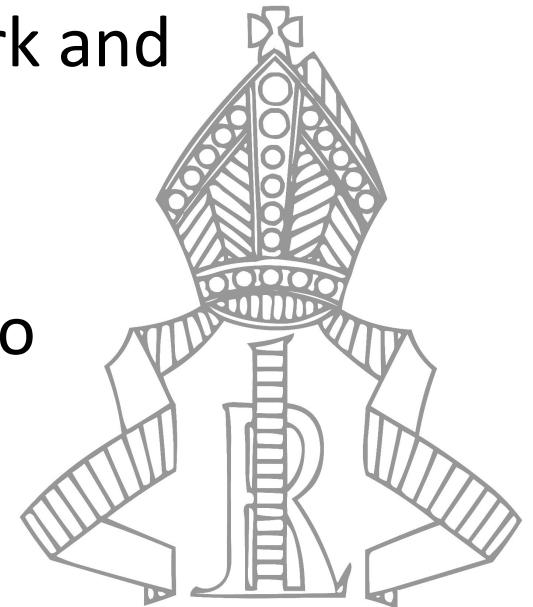
What we will do to support their learning

- Support the creation and use of action plans.
- Provide revision sessions /resources (usually after the mocks).
- Provide pastoral support - tutor/ HOH.
- Talk to each other.
- Talk to you.
- Set up intervention programmes.
- Deliver a careers programme.



What happens between now and next term?

- Encourage them to create revision resources for what they've learnt this year
- Prepare them for a different experience at school next term
- Ensure they are getting a good balance between work and recreation - but don't ignore that they may need to complete some tasks over the holidays
- Create/maintain an environment at home for them to study for next term
