

## Year 11 Art Curriculum Map

Overview	In Year 11 less directed projects are set, leading pupils towards confident independence. Students are expected to effectively develop their ideas, through purposeful investigation; demonstrating their critical and contextual understanding. They must complete a personal and meaningful final response, during their GCSE Mock exam in November. Students continue to refine and extend project work leading towards the final coursework deadline at the beginning of January. From January onwards, they begin work on their Externally Set Assignment, which culminates in the 10 hour GCSE Art Exam in the second half of the Summer Term.
