



Year 7 Latin Curriculum Map

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| Overview | During Year 7, students at Bishop Luffa have the opportunity to learn four languages. Students will learn to analyse foreign languages and look for patterns and links with their mother tongue. They will start the year studying Latin and how languages evolved to then move into Modern Foreign Languages (German, French and Spanish). Students will also study the culture and lifestyle of the countries where these languages are spoken. In the summer term, students are given the opportunity to independently explore and research languages in order to perform in the Languages Festival. They will also have the chance to complete activities in other languages such as, Swedish, Greek, Russian and Aboriginal by using the skills they have developed throughout the year to 'break the code'. At the end of the academic year students will choose the language they want to study from Year 8 until the end of KS4. |
